



The Government can also win

- by granting the Pony Club a lease on a portion of the site occupied by the club.
- by incorporating the site occupied by the Pony Club as an integral open space within the remainder of the site, which could still be offered as a housing development.

The riders could win by

- having a security of tenure and being allowed to invest more in the site

The horse community could win by

- being reassured our government holds the sector in high regard, and that dispossession is not a given, even in constrained times when economic rationalism prevails over all
- The disabled community could win by having an RDA service in their locality
- Coexistence with other community groups

We urgently seek a meeting to discuss with you our vision for the positive future of this site, and trust that a shared view, with a win-all-round outcome, can be achieved.
